Finland Snowmobile & ATV Club A Tradition of Trails and Community

The history of snowmobiling in Finland, Minnesota, reaches back to the 1960s, when a few dedicated pioneers set the stage for a tradition that still thrives today. In 1967, the Finland Snowmobile Club was officially established to maintain and improve local trails. Among its earliest leaders were Bonnie and Wally Tikkanen, who not only served as the first president and secretary but also ran one of the area's first snowmobile dealerships. Long before an official trail system existed, they led rides across logging roads and forest paths, helping to grow the sport in the North Shore region.

Today, the organization continues as the Finland Snowmobile & ATV Club, proudly maintaining over 30 miles of trails and carrying on a strong tradition of volunteerism and community service.

Key Milestones

Early 1960s: A local Scorpion snowmobile dealership sparks interest in the sport.

1966: Bonnie and Wally Tikkanen begin selling snowmobiles and lead early rides through the woods.

1967: The Finland Snowmobile Club is officially formed with the Tikkannens as charter members and leaders.

Following Years: The club commits to maintaining and improving trails, becoming a cornerstone of local recreation.

Today: The Finland Snowmobile & ATV Club group grooms and maintains trails for both snowmobilers and ATV riders.

Our Legacy

What started as a grassroots effort in the 1960s has grown into a vital community organization. The Finland Snowmobile & ATV Club continues to bring people together, support recreation, and protect the trail systems that remain a treasured resource for generations to come.

Silver Trail Riders Club History

The Silver Trail Riders, a snowmobile and ATV club based in Silver Bay, Minnesota, was founded in 1969 by local snowmobilers dedicated to building and maintaining trails. While the club's early focus was on snowmobiling, it later expanded to include ATVs as the sport gained popularity, ensuring year-round recreation opportunities for the community.

Key Milestones

1969 – Founding: Established by local snowmobilers who developed trails around Silver Bay.

Expansion: Adapted to include ATVs, maintaining trails for both summer and winter riding.

Today: A non-profit organization that maintains more than 60 miles of trails.

Trail Support: Funded through Minnesota Grant-in-Aid monies, membership dues, and donations.

Community Partnership: Works with neighboring clubs, including the Wild Country ATV Club and the Finland Snowmobile & ATV Club, to co-sponsor events such as the ATV Minnesota Ride & Rally.

Trail System: Maintains major routes like the Red Dot Trail, with connections to the Moose Walk and Moose Run trails.

Landowner Support: Relies on the cooperation of local landowners who make the trail system possible.

For over 50 years, the Silver Trail Riders have been a cornerstone of outdoor recreation in the Silver Bay area, committed to maintaining safe, scenic trails and fostering community through volunteerism and partnerships.

Wild Country ATV Club Two Harbors, MN

The Wild Country ATV Club is proud to serve as one of the host clubs for the 2025 ATV MN State Ride & Rally.

Based in Two Harbors, the club is dedicated to building, maintaining, and promoting safe, sustainable ATV trails that showcase the beauty of Minnesota's North Shore. With an active membership and a strong community spirit, the Wild Country ATV Club works to ensure enjoyable riding opportunities for generations to come.

ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE ASSOCIATION OF MINNESOTA, INC.



The All-Terrain Vehicle Association of Minnesota, Inc., first organized in 1983, is a non-profit corporation under Minnesota Statutes Chapter 317A. It is composed of individual, family and business members. The management of the All-Terrain Vehicle Association of Minnesota (ATV MN) occurs through the State Board of Directors. The daily direction of ATV MN is conducted by the Executive Board, as delegated and overseen by the State Board of Directors.

ATV MN was established to serve the interests of all-terrain vehicle (ATV) owners by advocating for ATV recreation, advancing the safe use of ATVs, providing information, and participating in legislative and regulatory activities related to the use of ATVs.

Major accomplishments in ATV recreation since the formation of ATV MN include:

- ATV registration program and dedicated fund account established
- ATV Grant-in-Aid trail grant program established
- ATV youth safety training program established
- Trail Ambassador Program initiated
- ATV funding increased from gas tax refund formula change
- Thousands of miles of ATV Grant-in-Aid trails were constructed and maintained, using best practices to ensure they are economically and environmentally sustainable.

ATV MN Mission Statement

- Advocate for ATV recreation with a focus on the benefits of responsible behavior.
- Advance and foster the increasing recognition and acceptance that ATV recreation is an important component within the recreational opportunities, recreational system, and economy of the State of Minnesota.
- Assist in the establishment of new clubs and strengthening of existing clubs which share the vision and values of ATV MN
- Promote the safe use of ATVs and partner in the ATV adult and youth rider safety training program in Minnesota
- Promote responsible ATV use and rider behavior regarding respect for the environment, other recreational uses, and the law.
- Serve as a source of information regarding ATV recreation, clubs, activities, and significant issues regarding the sport.
- Participate in the legislative process and public agency planning or actions on matters which affect ATV recreation.

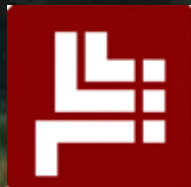

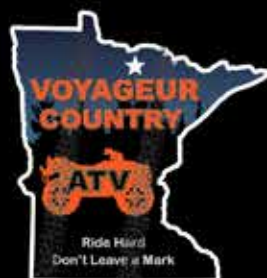

THE TRESTLE INN ISABELLA, MN

A Unique Story

The owners of Crooked Lake Resort initially opened the off-the-beaten-path country saloon to handle the large number of snowmobilers coming through. One day, while snowmobiling, they encountered an abandoned railroad trestle last used in the 1920s deep in the Superior National Forest. The timbers are estimated to be 300 years old.
